REVIEW

- Government offices not required to provide a report on each LAA target this year but will comment on key issues including CAA red flags
- Government office leads will work with local leads to review progress taking the LAA performance report as the starting point

KEY ISSUES

- How well is the partnership performing against the LAA target and eventual outcome?

and

- Are there any areas of good practice to be identified?
- Are there any clear risks to future delivery?

POTENTIAL ISSUES

or

- What are the causes of the under-performance?
- Are the key actions set out in plans for improvement sufficient to address underperformance?
- What support can GO-East (or regional partners) offer?

REFRESH

- Economic indicators where the recession has had a significant impact (NIs 151, 152 and 154)
- Where there is a technical issue with the indicator (e.g. NI 1)
- Indicators where we have not yet been able to set a target (e.g. NI 54)
- Where the local area has made a case for renegotiating the target (e.g. NI 173)



DATES

14 January 2010 – report to LPSB (near-final regional summary and proposals for renegotiated targets)

29 January 2010 – refreshed LAA submitted to GO-East

March 2010 – GO-East submit to Department for Communities and Local Government for ministerial approval
